

Landscape Painting Workshop



Create a frame to work in using masking tape.



Using a pencil draw in a scribbly horizon line and then draw a zig-zaggy line down the middle.



Draw lines in a slant in the sky going from left to right and then add some wavy scribble in the bottom corners.



Paint some white into the sky.



Add some paynes grey or mix little black into your blue.

Fill in the sky.



Using the green, start painting in the landscape.



Now add some yellow.



Your painting should be looking good so far. Well done!



Next mix the green with a little paynes grey to make it a darker tone.

Paint a line of dark green to the right side.



Now add some lighter green in the corner.



Add another layer of green over on the left hand corner.



Add a little more depth to the sky with paynes grey.



Paint some pink into the sky.

Mix up some purple and add it to the landscape.



Add one last line of purple for the shadow of the clouds.



Holding the end of your pencil add a some loose gestural zig-zaggy lines by rotating your pencil in your fingers.



Now you are nearly finished. Time to peel off the masking tape.
